

HOW WOULD THE PROPOSED NEW ROAD SYSTEM WORK?

Radstock Action Group asked BANES Development and Major Projects to clarify by saying which of the following statements was correct or not. You can see their replies in the third column.

	Statement	Correct (C) Not correct (N)
1.	Frome Road from Charlton Corner to County Bridge will be one way running towards County Bridge	N – two way traffic will be maintained but for access only. Buses only will be allowed to use this as a through route to the A367 (one way)
2.	All traffic coming into Radstock from Bath A367 and wishing to go to Frome will turn left into the Street and then go over the traffic lights, in front of the Victoria Hall and then right onto the Frome Road	N- Traffic heading for Frome will go straight on at the new signal controlled junction of The Street/ new link Rd/Frome Road
3.	All traffic coming into Radstock from Bath A367 and wishing to go to Haydon will turn left into the Street and then go over the traffic lights towards Haydon	N- Traffic signals are not being provided on The Street/Fortescue/Church Rd junction. A right hand turn lane is to be provided for vehicles turning into Church Road for Haydon
4.	All buses coming from A367 Bath will turn left into the Street and then go across the traffic lights, past the Victoria Hall and left into the remains of Frome Road	C- However the signal controlled junction is not in front of the Victoria Hall but on the new link Rd/ Frome Rd as stated above.
5.	All HGVs coming from Haydon and wishing to go to Frome will go down the Street towards A367 and turn right round the new roundabout outside the Coop and back along the Street, across the traffic lights, past the Victoria Hall and right up the Frome Road	C – but junction as in 2 above
6.	All cars coming from Haydon and wishing to go to Frome will go down the Street towards A367 and turn right round the new roundabout outside the Coop and back along the Street, across the traffic lights, past the Victoria Hall and right up the Frome Road	C – but junction as in 2 above
7.	Cars coming down from Haydon wishing to go into Fortescue Road will go across the traffic lights directly into Fortescue Road and not have to go down the Street	N- All traffic coming from Haydon will have to turn left at the junction with the Street
8.	HGVs coming down from Haydon wishing to go into Fortescue Road will go across the traffic lights directly into Fortescue Road and not down the Street towards the A367	N- All traffic coming from Haydon will have to turn left at the junction with the Street
9.	Cars coming down from Haydon will all go down the Street	C- Left turn only at the junction
10.	HGVs coming down from Haydon will all go down the Street	C- Left turn only at the junction
11.	Buses coming from Wells A367 and stopping in Radstock will all turn right into the Street at the new roundabout, go across the traffic lights, past the Victoria Hall and out onto the Frome Road towards County Bridge where they will turn left	C- but buses will be able to turn left or right at the junction with the A367
12.	Buses exiting Frome Road will be permitted to turn either left or right	C
13.	No buses will go into Fortescue Road under any circumstances	C
14.	HGVs will be able to exit Fortescue Road by turning either left or right	N- There will be left turn only for all vehicles coming from Fortescue Rd onto the A367
15.	HGVs will be able to exit Fortescue Road by turning only left	C
16.	HGVs will be able to exit Fortescue Road by turning only right	N

	Statement	Correct (C) Not correct (N)
17.	Cars will be able to exit Fortescue Road by turning either left or right	N- There will be left turn only for all vehicles coming from Fortescue Rd onto the A367
18.	Cars will be able to exit Fortescue Road by turning only left	C
19.	Cars will be able to exit Fortescue Road by turning only right	N
20.	No traffic will be permitted to turn left from the Street into Fortescue Road	N
21.	No traffic will be able to turn right from in front of the Victoria Hall into Fortescue Road	N – A right turn lane will be provided on The Street for traffic turning into Fortescue Rd
22.	Traffic coming from Frome and wishing to go to Haydon will cross in front of the Victoria Hall and turn left	C
23.	Traffic coming from Bath A367 and going to Wells will go straight up Wells Road and not through the town centre	C
